Extended coverage of a proceedings shall not be permitted unless notice of intention to provide extended coverage of a proceeding is given by the media to the clerk of court at least 20 days in advance of the proceeding, providing that only reasonable notice shall be required for coverage of expedited proceedings not regularly calendared.

If a request for extended media coverage is received, all counsel will be notified and given time to object. The objection and the reasons therefor should be communicated to the clerk of court within the time provided in Section III of the Appendix to Canon 3.
