Rule 1-1. BINDER OR COVER FOR RECORDS IN APPEALS

(Adopted November 26, 1986)

(Filed November 26, 1986)

Effective for appeals lodged on or after January 1, 1987, all records shall be found in strong, flexible, looseleaf binders or covers of 25 pt. pressboard material. The front cover shall be 9" x 14-1/2" and the back cover shall be 9" x 15-1/4", so as to allow a 3/4" tab on the back cover. Covers shall have 1" hinged flaps with two reinforced holes, 4-1/4" center to center and 9/16" top to center, end-tab scored for label placement, and shall be fastened at the top, so as to open flat at the top.
