



## **COURT OF APPEAL, SECOND CIRCUIT**

### **Rule 2-3. Failure to File Briefs, Criminal Cases**

**(Adopted by Court Conference as Rule 2-2, April 6, 1984. Renumbered as Rule 2-3 effective May 1, 1996.)**

If counsel in a criminal case does not file a brief within the time specified either by Rules 2-12.7 or 2-12.8, URCA, or by the court, the court may order counsel to file a brief within a delay fixed by the court.

If counsel fails to file a brief within the delay ordered by the court under this special rule, the court may cite counsel for contempt and impose penalties as provided by CCrP Arts. 17-25.
